



PERMIT APPLICATION TO ATTEND NON-CUNY INSTITUTION

Students who wish to take courses at a non-CUNY college while still taking courses at John Jay College at the same semester must complete this application. Students who have earned over 60 credits cannot apply for permit to a non-CUNY community college. Course description from the other institution will be used as the basis of course equivalency at John Jay. Approval of permit does not constitute registration of the course at the host college. Upon receiving approval, students must contact the host college to register for the approved course(s). Grade(s) received as a permit course is not computed into the student's grade point average at the home college. Upon completing the course, a copy of the official transcript must be sent from the host college. Transcript of permit courses not received after the end of the semester may result in loss of financial aid eligibility.
